Your Kaiser Permanente Optical Benefits are richer than before at no additional cost. Use your benefits to purchase prescription eyeglasses or contact lenses. Visit kp2020.org to make an appointment to shop at your Optical Center.

Old Benefits

- \$175 allowance is applied towards cost of frames, lenses, and contact lenses every 24 months¹

New Benefits

- frames up to \$200 every 24 months and standard plastic lenses every 12 months at no charge¹
- in lieu of glasses, contact lens allowance is \$200 every 12 months¹

Example: \$150 frame with standard lenses

Old \$175 Benefit Plan

Frame	\$200
Standard plastic lens	+ \$49
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	\$249

Allowance - \$175

Member pays out-of-pocket \$74

VS

New \$200 Benefit Plan

Frame	\$200
Standard plastic lens	+ \$0
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	\$200

Allowance - \$200

Member pays out-of-pocket \$0

Example: contact lenses

\$175 allowance towards contact lenses every **24 months**. Any leftover allowance can be used towards purchasing prescription glasses.

VS

\$200 allowance towards contact lenses every **12 months** in lieu of glasses.

¹Allowance can only be used towards prescription glasses and prescription contact lenses in Kaiser Permanente Optical Centers.
