MEASURE TO BE VOTED ON AND NOTICE OF DATE FIXED FOR SUBMITTING ARGUMENTS ON THE CITY OF SANGER SPECIAL SALES TAX FOR PUBLIC SAFETY MEASURE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to all qualified electors that the following measure is to be voted on at the Municipal Election to be held in the City of Sanger of Fresno County California, on Tuesday, November 8, 2016:

SANGER PUBLIC SAFETY SALES TAX EXTENSION ORDINANCE. To reduce gang/drug crimes, maintain 911 emergency response times, provide gang/drug prevention programs; prevent cuts to and retain/maintain police officers, paramedics, firefighters; increase school/neighborhood police patrols; shall the ordinance be adopted continuing the existing voter-approved 3/4 cent sales tax with no tax rate increase, providing \$1,900,000 annually, for ten years, requiring citizens' oversight, independent financial audits, all funds for City of Sanger public safety?

SYNOPSIS OF MEASURE

Notice is hereby given that the following measure is to be voted on at the general municipal election to be held in the City of Sanger, on Tuesday, November 8, 2016.

ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE APPROVING EXTENSION OF CURRENT THREE QUARTER CENT (.75%) TRANSACTIONS AND USE (SALES) TAX FOR PUBLIC SAFETY, WITH NO INCREASE IN CURRENT TAX RATE, UNTIL JUNE 30, 2028.

The proposed ordinance would approve the extension of the City's current ¾ (.75%) sales tax dedicated and expended only for Police, Fire, Paramedic, 9-1-1 Emergency Response and Gang/Drug Prevention. The authority to levy the tax would continue for ten years. The current sales tax ordinance would otherwise remain unchanged.

Arguments for or against the measure may be submitted to the Fresno County Clerk/Elections, 2221 Kern St., Fresno, CA 93721, no later than Monday, August 22, 2016. Paper copies of arguments must be submitted with original signatures, as well as on CD in MS Word format. No argument shall exceed 300 words in length. Arguments may be submitted by the legislative body, or any member or members of the legislative body authorized by that body, or any individual voter who is eligible to vote on the measure, or bona fide association of citizens, or any combination of voters and associations. No more than five signatures shall appear with any argument submitted. If an argument is signed by more than five persons, the names of only the first five persons signing, determined by the order in which their signatures appear, shall be printed with the argument.

Only one argument for and one argument against each measure will be selected for printing and distribution to the voters. Preference and priority in selection will be given in the order named: (1) The legislative body, or member or members of the legislative body authorized

by that body; (2) The individual voter or bona fide association of citizens, or combination of voters and associations, who are the bona fide sponsors or proponents of the measure; (3) Bona fide associations of citizens; (4) Individual voters who are eligible to vote on the measure. Any argument submitted shall not be changed after August 22, 2016.
