SUBJECT: Authority to Require Direct Deposit

Your Board recently requested that Administration determine if direct deposit could be required for all recurring benefit payments. This request was the result of numerous complaints of late receipt and non-receipt of paper benefit checks by our recipients. After researching California statutes and obtaining input from legal counsel, we have determined that your Board cannot require the use of direct deposit.

Please be aware, that FCERA staff and Administration strongly encourage the use of direct deposit. The topic is discussed during retirement counseling sessions and seminars, in the member handbooks and newsletter, as well as when returned mail is processed. However, for reasons known only to the participant, some people do not wish to use direct deposit. FCERA has reimbursed members for late fees, returned check fees, etc. that resulted from late/non-delivery of a check.

For those people that wish to continue receiving a paper check, the attached letter was drafted to remind them of the risks they are taking in connection with the possible late/non-receipt of the check and informing them that FCERA will not be liable for any costs incurred as a result of late or non-receipt of their monthly benefit checks. This letter will be provided to all beneficiaries that are currently receiving a paper check and during retirement counseling sessions. It will also be posted on FCERA's website and included in a future newsletter.

With your concurrence, FCERA will immediately begin distributing the attached letter. Please let me know if you have any questions or concerns about this topic.

The Fresno County Employees' Retirement Association (FCERA) would like to take a moment to address concerns regarding the delivery of monthly benefits paid by paper check. While we strive to meet our members' expectations, there are some instances for which we have no control. That being said FCERA would like to note that benefit checks received by mail are not considered late until the 10th calendar day after expected delivery, which is the last County of Fresno business day of each month. Should there be an extended delay in delivery that is caused by weather or other event outside the control of FCERA or its disbursement bank, FCERA can not be held liable for any fees or other implications that may occur. However, a delay resulting from FCERA's operational delays, including FCERA's disbursement bank delays, will be dealt with on a case by case basis.

In order to reduce situations which could result in a delay of benefit payment, the Board of Retirement highly recommends the use of direct deposit. The utilization of direct deposit removes most reasons for delay and provides immediate access to funds on the day of payment. In addition a monthly benefit statement with an advice attached will be mailed to the address provided for record keeping. To establish direct deposit a signed direct deposit form is required. A direct deposit form is attached for your use.
