RETIREMENT SYSTEM

RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE
INCLUSION OF SUCH OFFICERS AND
ATTACHES IN SAID SYSTEM

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Municipal and Justice Court Act of 1949, there has been established a municipal court within the County of Fresno known and designated as the Municipal Court of the Fresno Judicial District, County of Fresno, State of California; and

WHEREAS, the officers and attaches of said Municipal Court become members of the Fresno County Employees Retirement System only by a 4/5th vote of the Board of Supervisors, pursuant to Section 31555 of the Government Code; and

WHEREAS, it appears that numerous such officers and attaches have previously belonged to said retirement system and their rights would be seriously jeopardized unless their membership therein is continued, and that other officers and attaches in said court are desirous of becoming members of said retirement system;

NOW, THEREFORE, upon motion of Supervisor Cadwallader, seconded by Supervisor Malm, and carried, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the officers and attaches of the Municipal Court of the Fresno Judicial District, except judges and officers and attaches who are participating in any system established pursuant to Chapter 4, Title 3, Division 4, Part 3 of the Government Code, shall be included within the membership of the County Employees Retirement System of the County of Fresno in the manner provided by Section 31555 of the Government Code of the State of California.
