- Q1. Do the 11 facilities currently have SPCC plans?
- A1. The plans are outdated

The Reedley site has been closed and no longer requires a SPCC plan, making the total number of plans needed now ten (10).

- Q2. What is the date for each plan (that is, when were the plans last updated or amended)?
- A2. 2001
- Q3. If so, what consulting firm or agency developed them?
- A3. Krazan
- Q4. Are native/editable Word and AUTOCAD files available for the winning bidder?
- A4. There are no as builts.
- Q5. Can electronic copies of each plan be provided to the bidders for review and as an aid in developing the level of effort and cost in the proposal?
- A5. Sample site maps will be available to the successful bidder
- Q6. What is the approximate size (acres) of each facility?
- A6. This varies per site.
- Q7. How many and what type/capacity of oil storage tanks and systems (i.e., pipelines, loading/unloading racks, electrical transformers, oil water separators, etc.) exist for each facility? Can an inventory of these items for each facility be provided?
- A7. There are no loading/unloading racks. Storage tanks are fuel only.
