QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Q1. Examination of the Site. On page 7 of the RFQ, it mentions that bidders should examine the site before bidding. I wondered if we need to actually visit the 10 facilities or if our review of the aerial photographs will suffice?

A1. It is recommended you visit the sites, However it is not mandatory if you are able to provide an accurate bid based on an aerial photo.

Q2. Use of the facilities. I am wondering if the County does vehicle maintenance at the facilities in question.

A2. Minor maintenance done at some of the sites, such as oil and filter changes.

Q3. Number of Copies. On page 4 of the RFQ, it mentions that we need to provide 2 copies of the quotation. I'm not sure I understand what is meant by the quotation. Is that an accumulation of the forms that have been requested, or are you expecting a full proposal?

A3. At the very least you must submit all of the pages requiring a vendor response and all of the signed addendums

Q4. Each SPCC will require an inspection (similar to a monthly Designated Operator inspection). The SPCC inspection frequency is site specific. This brings up a question or two regarding the Scope of Work.

A4. Monthly site inspections are done by the County of Fresno.

Q5. Is the Scope Of Work to be interpreted as 'bidder to provide SPCC plans' only with no inspections?

A5. Bidder is not to provide any monthly inspections.
