Please take this letter with you to the Library.
- Should you choose to dispute the charges:
 - This must be done in writing to our Revenue Collection Unit with a valid reason for the dispute within 30 days from the date of this letter.
 - Our office will assume this debt is valid if a dispute letter has not been received within 30 days from the date of this letter.
- ➤ If you no longer possess the material(s) our office is requesting payment in full within 30 days. Failure to pay the balance in full or make suitable payment arrangements with our office will result in further collection activity.
