Additional Questions and Answers

- Q.1. Pg. 21 of RFP Corizon is a comprehensive healthcare services provider and as such, maintains healthcare professional liability and general liability coverage. Corizon is not a Social Services provider therefore does not maintain this specific coverage (Social Services Liability). Corizon's Professional and General Liability policies include coverage for allegations of sexual misconduct. Will the County accept our existing Professional and General Liability coverages in lieu of a specific Social Services Liability policy? We can provide language from our policy specific to this exposure and how it would respond. The purchase of a separate Social Services Liability policy would incur unnecessary costs with no foreseeable benefit.
- A.1. County's Risk Management stipulated that if Contractor's Professional and General Liability policies contain the same limits for allegations of sexual misconduct as the limits requested by the County for Child Abuse/Molestation & Social Services Coverage, this would be adequate. With that in mind, the issue would need to be revisited during contract negotiation.
- Q.2. Pg. 22 of RFP The County has asked the Contractor to carry a Professional Liability policy with limits of no less than \$3,000,000 per occurrence and \$5,000,000 annual aggregate. The majority of the clients we work with accept the industry standard limits of \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$3,000,000 annual aggregate. Would the County accept these lower limits?
- A.2. Reducing the limits is not recommended by County Risk Management; however, the issue would need to be revisited during contract negotiation.

Pending Questions from Addendum One (1):

- Q.20. Page 39 Medical/Legal Issues Will it be the Contractor's mental health personnel that will be responsible for juvenile competency evaluations for the courts?
- A.20. This question was submitted as written above and then asked again at the Bidder's Conference in a different manner. The Purchasing Manager requested the bidder submit the question again in writing for clarification, which was not received by the closing date for all bidder questions.

The answer given at the Bidder's Conference was the following:

No, it is not the Contractor's mental health personnel that are responsible for the official juvenile competency evaluations for the courts. It is required per IMQ standards that an independent psychiatrist assumes the responsibility to determine a juvenile's competency. However, the Contractor's mental health personnel can submit reports of their own findings regarding the juvenile to the courts for consideration.

- Q.30. May we obtain a copy of the agreement with Regents of the University of California, San Francisco (UCSF) to ascertain all services currently provided?
- A.30. Any bidders that were unable to use the link to the UCSF Agreement provided in Addendum One (1), please contact <u>rbynum@co.fresno.ca.us</u> for a pdf copy of the Agreement.
- Q.38. What is the current length of hospital stay (9/12 to 8/13), broken down by month?
- A.38. DPH Jail Response: Information regarding average inpatient hospitalization length of stay for medical care is provided in Addendum Two (2), see "Exhibit D5".

DPH JJC Response: As mentioned in Addendum One (1), this information is not available for juvenile wards; inpatient hospitalizations for juveniles seldom occur.

- Q.39. How many events has the county had in the last 1 year on off-site? Please break it down to Inpatient, ER, Office Visit, One day Surgery, Dialysis, and X-Ray.
- A.39. Data regarding all off-site/clinic services from October 2012 through September 2013 is provided in Addendum Two (2): for information regarding number of medical inpatient hospitalizations, see "Exhibit D5"; and for the number of off-site/clinic services provided for both Jail and JJC, see "Exhibit D6".
- Q.40. How much (in dollars) has the County spent in the last year on off-site? Please categorize as: Inpatient, ER, Office Visit, One day Surgery, Dialysis, and X- Ray.
- A.40. The capitated payment that the County pays for off-site inmate services is combined with the payment for W&I Code 17000 indigent care payments. The inmate portion of that payment is approximately \$2,977,052 for emergency room and specialty care services provided off-site. No further breakdown of categorized service payments is available.
- Q.63. Are exceptions to outside medications made when medical urgency dictates their need and usage?
- A.63. Contractor shall expect that there should be no exceptions regarding outside medication usage within the Jail and JJC facilities. To avoid any unforeseen issues, Contractor should have a back-up local pharmacy in place to provide STAT response for pharmaceuticals.
- Q.72. What has the pharmacy spent from 9/12 to 8/13 by month?
- A.72. As mentioned in Addendum One (1), the pharmaceutical costs from June 2012 through May 2013 were provided in the RFP, see page 8 of Exhibit D. For pharmaceutical costs from June 2013 through August 2013 for both the Jail and JJC, see "Exhibit D2", provided in Addendum Two (2).

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- Q.73. Please furnish the top 50 drugs for the past 12 months. Please give name, qty, price per unit and NDC.
- A.73. The top 50 medications utilized during the previous twelve (12) months (as of August 2013) are provided in the RFP Addendum Two (2). The top 50 reports are classified as follows:
