QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

Q1. Will there be any changes in contract since the last one?

A1. There are no boiler plate contract language changes. The contract terms will be negotiated with the awarded vendor(s) after Tentative Award notice is released.

Q2. What is the 10 year average?

A2. The 10 year average can be found in Exhibit C of the bid packet.

Q3. What is the main reason for 70% minimum instead of 80%?

A3. The decrease in percentage minimum was an administrative decision based on the snowfall in recent years.

Q4. Are we looking for one contractor?

A4. No, contractors will bid on each zone separately. There can be as few as one contract and as many as nine depending on the bids.

Q5. Is there still a 90 days written notice to get out of the contract prior to the full three years?

A5. Per the current model contract:

TERMINATION:
Without Cause -

Under circumstances other than those set forth above, this Agreement may be terminated by COUNTY upon the giving of thirty (30) days advance written notice of an intention to terminate to CONTRACTOR.

Q6. If awarded the contract for 3 years do you have to rebid in 2 years?

A6. This contract is for 3 years with 2 additional one year extensions based upon mutual written consent of both parties. An awarded vendor can choose to decline to extend their contract at the end of the three year initial term.
