**SUBJECT:** Authorize President to Execute a Joint Powers Agreement and Program Memorandum of Understanding Required by PRISM for Continued Participation in the Crime Program for the San Joaquin Valley Insurance Authority (A)

**REQUEST(S):** That the Board authorize the President to Execute a Joint Powers Agreement and Memorandum of Understanding for the SJVIA Crime Program through PRISM.

**DESCRIPTION:**

PRISM now requires a signed Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for every program in which an entity participates. Additionally, any entity not currently enrolled in a “Major” program must execute a Joint Powers Agreement (JPA).

The list below outlines the SJVIA’s current program participation, and the specific documents required by June 30, 2026.
